**Chairmans Report**

Dear Councillors and Parishioners of Irby Upon Humber

Firstly, I would like to thank the council for their support during 2025/2026 and most importantly the parishioners for their understanding regarding the drastic raise in the precept, not a good start to the new financial year, however, this was a necessity to ensure the parish council are abiding by risk management and council policies.

The raise in the precept was to safeguard the council due to the number of complaints received to the external auditor relating to the 2024/2025 finances, unfortunately, even if the complaints are not upheld, they still require investigation which results in cost implications to the parish.

Going forward, the council can confidently state the finance management for 2025/2026 has been in accordance with the JPAG accountability guide as well as the council now having a functional up-to-date website to promoting transparency for the parishioners of Irby, having access to meeting minutes, councillor details and the finances.
